**Camanachd Association** The Camanachd Association is the ruling body of the ancient and unique stick sport of shinty in its modern dynamic form.




**Clay Pigeon Shooting Association** The CPSA is the national governing body for clay target shooting in England.

**England Squash** England Squash is responsible for the organisation and promotion of squash in England.



**English Amateur Dancesport Association** EADA is the voice of amateur competitive dancesport in England. As well as being a member of the International Dancesport Federation (IDSF), EADA is the only UK dancesport association (professional or amateur) which is recognised and supported by Sport England.




**English Curling Association** The English Curling Association aims to support, promote and develop the sport of curling in England and unite curlers throughout England in the brotherhood of curling.



**English Golf Union** The EGU has served as the governing body of male amateur golf in England since it was founded in 1924. CASC Champion: Chris Hicks


**Ramblers' Association** The Ramblers' Association is Britain's biggest charity working to promote walking and to improve conditions for all walkers.



**Scottish Games Association** The SGA is the governing body of traditional highland games in Scotland.




